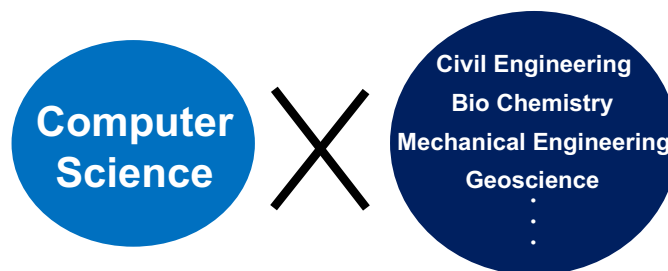


Japanese government (MEXT) scholarship opportunity for Doctoral Course enroll in Oct. 2025

Special program for priority placement of government-sponsored international students in Muroran Institute of Technology, Japan

–Computer Science Based Cross-disciplinary Innovation Program for International Professionals–



1. Program information

- This program will select and recommend limited numbers of 3 candidates among all applicants to MEXT (3 years scholarship for 3 doctoral students). The MEXT scholarship students are eligible only for international students from priority countries designated by Japanese Government.
- This program aims to nurture the next generation of “innovators” who can lead a smart society in the real world where globalization is advancing and conducts cross-disciplinary research and education based on computer science.
- Priority countries include (but are not limited to): Indonesia, Cambodia, Singapore, Thailand, Philippines, Brunei, Vietnam, Malaysia, Myanmar, Laos, India, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Egypt, etc.

2. Scholarship and other benefits

- Allowance: 145,000JPY per month.
- Screening, Entrance and tuition fees will be exempted.
- Traveling expenses: provide ticket to Japan as well as return ticket.

3. MEXT's qualifications

- An applicant must have academic ability equivalent to or greater than that of a master's degree of Japanese university.
- Age limitation: less than 35 as of April 1 in 2025.
- Language: Applicants must be proficient in the English (CEFR level B2 or higher) or Japanese (N2 or N1 of JLPT).

4. Important dates for Doctoral course applicant of Oct. 2025 enrollment

- **Scholarship application to MuroranIT by January, 2025.**
- Screening test for MEXT recommendation will be planned by MuroranIT (result notification by MuroranIT in March and by MEXT in June).
- Screening test for Doctoral Course will be planned.
- Admission period is October 2025.
